 - Zoning Amendment #1:

Amendment 1 Article IV Section 1001.2 Solar Panels

Section 1001.2 Solar Panels

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- A. Ground and roof mounted solar energy systems are permitted in all residential districts.
- B. Ground mounted systems may cover no more than one acre of land <u>for commercial</u> <u>applications. Regardless each and</u> must comply with lot coverage maximums specific to the underlying zoning district. Ground-mounted systems are conditional use in commercial and industrial zoning districts.
- C. Solar energy systems are conditional use in commercial and industrial zoning districts.
- D. All solar energy systems must be designed for on-site consumption.

Zoning Amendment #2:

Amendment 2 Article X Small Solar and Wind Energy Systems Section 1001.5

Section 1001.5 Wind Towers/turbines

- A. The total height of small wind energy systems is measured as the vertical distance from the ground level to the tip of a wind generator blade when the tip is at its highest point, and shall not exceed the following maximum height requirements:
 - a. Properties greater than two (2) acres to five (5) acres-maximum one hundred twenty (120) feet.
 - b. Properties greater than five (5) acres-maximum one hundred seventy (170) feet.
 - c. Properties within ten thousand (10,000) feet of an airport must comply with FAA height standards and regulations. Limit of one wind tower/turbine per property

- B) <u>Commercial for-profit resale of energy SALE OF WIND</u> AND SOLAR GENERATED ENERGY OFF-SITE.

<u>Revised: Off-site sale of wind and solar generated</u> <u>energy.</u>
